

<u>FOCUS ON MAFAMBISA – FORTNIGHT</u> Mafambisa fortnight continues - please find time to pray for the community of Mafambisa, in particular the care point and the children who attend. Please pray for the care workers who cook and care for the children and for the care givers who look after the

children in their homes. Please pray for Hands at Work who support and the Haziview Service Centre.

We have raised over £400 so far to pay for the construction of a house for Celine and her children. <u>CELINES HOUSE</u>. We have heard from Hands at Work that they need to build a house for a lady called Celine who is living in Mafambisa with her children but does not have a house to live in or to care for her children in!

Celine has been allowed to stay in other people's houses, whilst they are away doing peace work in Johannesburg. These arrangements often come to an end suddenly as the person whose house she is borrowing return as their work has finished. This is very disruptive to the children as Celine and her children often find themselves homeless again. Hands at work have decided to build a house for Celine on a plot of land that the chief has given to the church. This will cost £1600, and we would like to see if we can raise this during Mafambisa fortnight!
